- 1. Discussion between Jesus and his brothers, v3.
- 2. The world admires great shows, v4. The brothers taunt Jesus: show yourself to the world, you have a lot to offer!
- 3. Previously, a lot of people left Jesus, J 6.66. The brothers advise Jesus: you can gain more disciples, v3.
- 4. Lord Jesus lived by God's time plan. Timing of Jesus and of the brothers is different.
- 5. People like their religion which is popular. The Lord, on the other hand, gives an unpopular message.

- 1. What difference do you feel when someone is challenging you versus taunting you? Do you ever taunt God when you don't get what you want when you pray?
- 2. Choose one Options:
 - 1) Share an example when looking back God's timing was better than your timing.
 - 2) Share a time when you still wonder about why God timed things the way he did.
 - 3) Share about a time when you didn't get what you wanted or planned but God made a different plan.

- 3. Without looking at the book of John write down the main sections of John through Chapter 6. In your opinion what were the main points John was trying to communicate in the first 6 Chapters about Jesus? How do the first 6 chapters fulfill the purpose of John writing this book (John 20:30-31)?
- 4. Jesus talks about God's timing in these verses. What other parts of the Bible do you see God having different timing than people. One example to get you started is the story of Abraham (Gen 12:1-3, Gen 15:1-6, Gen 16:1-4, Gen 17:1-2, Gen 21:1-7).

- 5. We say in the "Our Father" prayer ... "may your will be done on earth as it is in heaven". Jesus knew God's will and plan for him. How do you determine God's will? Are there guidelines you use to knowing what God's will or plan is?
- 6. Read John 15:18-19 and I Peter 3:15. In John 7:6, Jesus talks about the world hating Him because He tells the world the evil things that it does. How do you share with gentleness and respect but also realize that the people you share with may hate you? How do you deal with this tension?
- 7. Choose one person you know who is an unbeliever and pray that God would give you an opportunity to talk to that person in the next two weeks. Pray for God's timing and pray that God will lead you in what to say.
